Learning from Steelhead Fly Fishing Tactics

with John Sherman

While many people consider steelhead fly fishers a group of somewhat strange masochists (steelhead being the fish of a thousand casts, the weather often cold, etc.), we all should admit that tactics developed by steelheaders have helped everyone who is going to a trout stream. These tactics include the recent success of spey casting techniques (which are not just for two-handed rods but also for eight and nine foot, single-handed rods), but nymphing strategies as well and how to search for and locate fish. No one knows this better than John Sherman who, in addition to traveling regularly in California, Nevada, Arizona and Hawaii representing Simms fly fishing gear and Hatch Outdoors sales (especially their fine reels), has fished **a lot** for steelhead in California, Oregon, Washington and British Columbia.

John has presented to our clubs before and, because of his highly professional photography skills and his wonderful storytelling abilities, has impressed everyone in SoCal. This month will be no exception, with John being the perfect guide for this topic -- we will see and learn about all the wonderful opportunities to fish up and down the left side of the country and how to increase our fishing skills for different species.

John was born and raised in Visalia, California where, at eight years of age and hanging around Buz's, the local fly shop, he learned how to fly fish. In 1999, John graduated from California State University Chico with a degree in Business Administration and Marketing. But fly fishing was his passion, so after graduation, he spent two months fishing for steelhead in British Columbia. (Didn't want to rush that getting down to work routine.)

While attending Chico State, John worked at the Powell Fly Shop and guided on the Feather and Sacramento Rivers for steelhead and salmon. Since then, John has fished the West Coast from Alaska to the Baja Peninsula for everything from steelhead, to salmon, stripers, black bass, trout and numerous blue water species. He has also hosted numerous trips around the globe, including taking fly fishers to such exotic locales as Australia, Russia, Iceland, Mexico, Canada, the Bahamas, Belize, Argentina and Indonesia. John is also a very accomplished outdoor photographer who has had his work published in magazines such as *Field & Stream*, *Fly Fisherman*, *Fly Rod & Reel*, *The Drake*, *California Fly Fisher*, *Northwest* and *Southwest Fly Fishing*. He has been documenting his expeditions with a camera since the age of 10.

A few years ago, John teamed up with Captain Mike Costello to produce the first and only fly fishing book dedicated to the California Delta, **Fly Fishing the California Delta**, which has been a top selling book since 2010. John lives in Discovery Bay, on the San Joaquin Sacramento River Delta with his wife Natih, daughter Kalum, son Kasix and dog Portis.

The What: An inter-club rod building challenge between SWCFFF affiliated, sponsored by the **Southern Sierra Fly Fishers Club**, to benefit the Southern California “Casting for Recovery” chapter.

The Why: To supply the So. Cal. CFR with enough rods and rod tubes to cover all the retreat participants. If a CFR chapter does not have all the necessary equipment to cover the retreats they need to get the equipment from the national headquarters. This requires the local chapter to use funds that would be better served on other expenses. This challenge is a start to get the So. Cal. CFR outfitted with their own supplies.

The Who: The challenge is open to any SWCFFF club and their members.

The When: The deadline to get the rods in will be the weekend of the 2014 SWCFFF Fly Fishing Faire in September.

The How: Simple..... you build a rod, donate it to the challenge, and your build is entered in the judging for the “Best of Show” plaque for you and your club.

The Goal: To supply at least 20 rods and rod tubes to our local “Casting for Recovery” chapter.

The Rules:

- #1 Build a 9', 5 wt., 4 piece rod, supply a rod tube and donate it for the challenge.
- #2 Build the rod to a CFR theme. There must be a bit of pink somewhere on the build.

The Judging: Two categories and all rods will be entered in both.

1. Craftsmanship: Based on basic rod building fundamentals. Fit and Finish is the #1 judging criteria.
2. Best of Show: This will be the best rod in the challenge. This is a category where all the extras will come into play.

Awards: Bragging rights. The SSFFC will supply a plaque to the winning club and individual builder. The real winner will be the Southern California “Casting for Recovery” chapter and all the future retreat participants.



Note: The SSFFC was able to get a good discount on 20 Batson blanks from Bill Batson. We will pass those savings on to you at our cost + shipping= \$35 per blank.
